

The 96 acres solar property comes complete with four bedrooms (one Altitude Room for comfortable, easy sleeping if you're not used to the altitude) and the master suite with balcony, three bathrooms, pool room, game room w/ karaoke stage, office, the great room upstairs has motorized blinds, 2 Big Buck fireplaces, propane direct vent heaters, Jacuzzi, walkout w/ flagstone patio, wrap-around deck, and RV cleanout. Also included are – Propane backup generator and a 1000-gallon septic with easy access. The lodge's internet provider is Starlink service. The property is easily 100% self-sustaining, even without the propane heaters, with Solar electricity and wood heat.

The shop comes equipped with maintenance equipment for roads.

Cabins

This property has two adorable primitive one-room cabins great for artists, writers, hunters, or just an amazing quiet time away from the pressures of the real world. Each cabin has its own water and a solar power source.

Aspen Glen Cabin (299 sf) is tucked away in the green lush cove covered with beautiful Aspens and lush meadows, while Piney Ridge Cabin (275 sf) is secluded in the tall forest pines, complete with a small green-house garden bed and large heavy-metal Quanset Hut for great toy storage or workshop.


