Location: This tract is located in northeastern Barton County, 12 miles south of Wilson, Kansas, 14 miles south of I-70 interstate, and 8 miles north of Claflin, Kansas. Located 1/2 mile south of NE 200 Rd. along NE 120 Ave.

Land

This area is very well known for large herds of some of the biggest deer in the State of Kansas as well as excellent upland bird numbers including quail, pheasants, and prairie chickens. The land's rolling topography enhances its natural appeal, featuring two wet weather creek beds, 26.69 acres of CRP, and multiple locations for a deer blind or tree stands. Additionally, there is an old pond bed completely surrounded by timber and thickets for an excellent stand location. The valleys and terrain changes on this tract make it an excellent travel corridor for the local White-tailed Deer herd. The diverse landscape of native grasses, trees, topography, and bedding areas help to create the perfect combination for all of the wild game in the area.

The current CRP contract is in effect through September of 2025, generating a total of \$947.00 per year or \$35.50 per acre. Additionally, sitting toward the western portion of the property lies a game watering trough catch system, used to catch rainwater for the local wildlife to drink. The property sits just 1 mile from a county blacktop, helping make this an ideal candidate for those looking to build their country dream home! 
