## **Water/Mineral Rights & Natural Resources**

0.5 Water Shares of Middle Valley Ditch Corporation and a waste water irrigation ditch provide water for the land via included wheel lines, big gun, and mobile pod sprinklers.









#### **Region & Climate**

Midvale, Idaho, experiences a semi-arid climate with distinct seasons. Summers in Midvale are warm and dry, with temperatures ranging from the mid-80s to low 90s. Winters, on the other hand, are cold and snowy, with temperatures dropping below freezing. Snowfall averages around 20 to 30 inches.

#### Location

Situated in the western region of Idaho, Midvale rests in a scenic valley bordered by rolling hills and the tranquil waters of the Weiser River. Found in Washington County, it's conveniently positioned between Boise, Idaho's capital, and the Oregon border. This central location makes Midvale easily accessible and approximately 85 miles to urban amenities. The economy is rooted in agriculture, with farming and ranching serving as key industries in the area.

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
