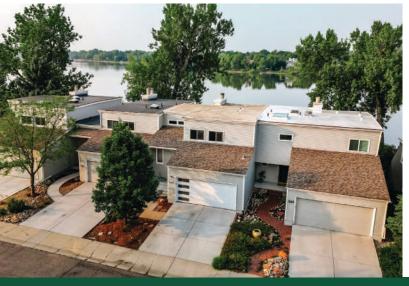

Other attractions in Fort Collins include Horsetooth Reservoir, Foothills Mall, and many different dining experiences.

Fort Collins is situated in northern Colorado at the foothills of the Rocky Mountains, about 60 miles north of Denver. The city lies on the eastern edge of the Rockies, with a landscape that transitions from flat plains to rugged mountains. At an elevation of approximately 5,000 feet, Fort Collins experiences a semi-arid climate with warm to hot summers, cold winters, and moderate snowfall. The city enjoys over 300 sunny days a year, with average precipitation around 15-20 inches annually, predominantly falling as rain in the summer and snow in the winter.

History

Fort Collins was established in 1864 as a military fort to protect settlers and support the construction of the transcontinental railroad. Named after Colonel William O. Collins of the U.S. Army, the fort was initially a key outpost during the Indian Wars. As the military presence dwindled, the area transitioned to a civilian town in the late 19th century. The presence of Colorado State University, founded in 1870 as the Colorado Agricultural College, significantly contributed to the city's growth and development. Over the years, Fort Collins has evolved into a vibrant city known for its strong educational institutions, craft breweries, and outdoor recreation opportunities.









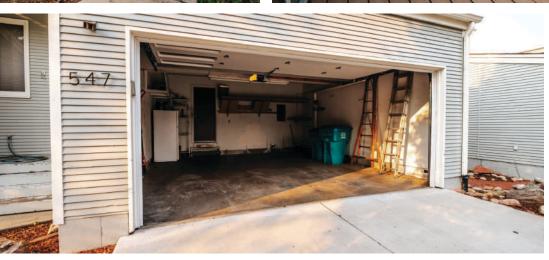

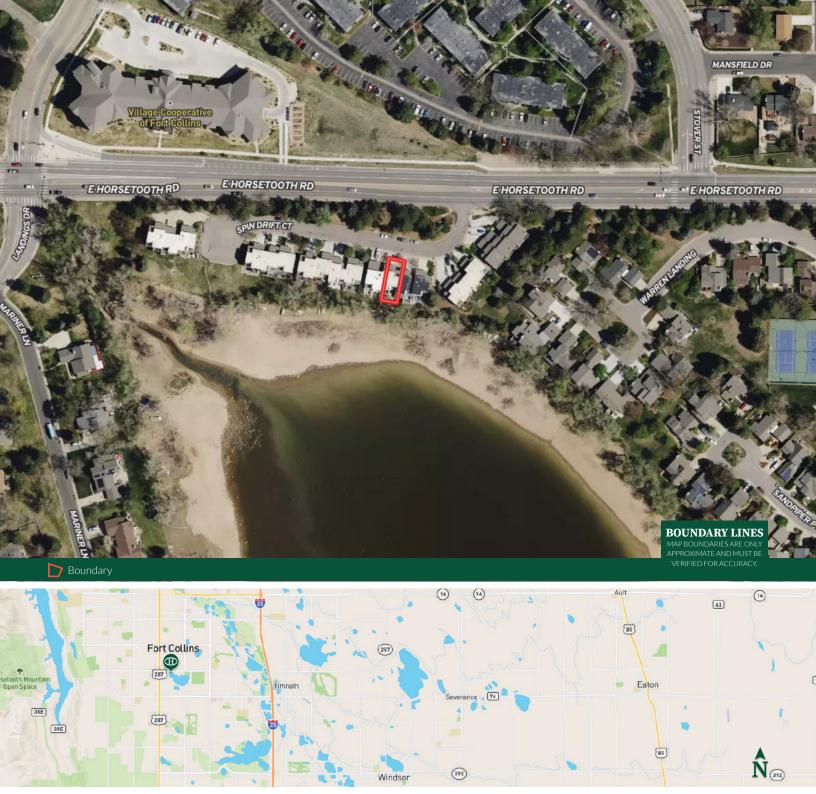
