Property Summary

Locating the epicenter where elk naturally gather is crucial for achieving consistent elk hunting success, and Half Moon Ranch East is that ranch. Lots of water, excellent feed sources, and healthy populations of trophy bull elk make Half Moon Ranch East one of the top hunting ranches in Montana.





Land

This property boasts 2190 total acres of which 1670 are deeded and 520 acres of BLM lease. There is 110 acres enrolled into a conservation easement along with the neighbors to the North East. This ranch has been in the same family since the early 1900's and its founder was a Centennial Cowboy. Historically the ranch was used as summer pasture for cow/calf pairs, but would make excellent yearling country.

There is a small cabin along the Flatwillow creek that can be used as a hunting cabin or weekend getaway spot. The other cabin and shop are located on the south and west side of the BLM and would make a great hunting cabin. It has two bedrooms and one bath, wood stove, fireplace, and deck to overlook the valley.





Recreation

The world-famous Big Snow and Little Snowy Mountains are renowned for world class trophy elk, deer, bear, mountain lion, and turkey hunting, or fishing on the North Fork of Flatwillow, Half Moon Ranch East has it all. From high tree-covered ridges to rolling grasslands to timbered coulees , this ranch has everything an outdoor enthusiast is looking for and is being offered turnkey with an attractive offer. Show up and start enjoying this property on day one of ownership. Located in hunting district 411, the property offers one of the largest elk herds in Montana. Elk herd numbers according to Montana Fish & Game are estimated to be over 10,000 head in the Snowy and Little Snowy Mountain region. The ranch generally harvests an average of two-three 340"-350"+ bulls annually. From chasing elk, deer, and bear in archery and rifle season to spot and stalk hunting or stand hunting, you will find plenty of opportunities to pursue big and small game animals. This exceptional, versatile ranch offers an ideal retreat for adventurous people seeking seclusion, privacy, and the great outdoors.

Agriculture

The vegetation varies from lush, rolling grass hills to stands of timber and aspen to chokecherry-filled draws and cottonwood stream bottoms. The water sources are year-round springs that surface in spots up and down the creek and throughout the mountains. The North Fork Flatwillow Creek itself is an outstanding fishery which is the central feature of the valley, is considered a full time creek and runs year-round.







Region & Climate

The Big and Little Snowy Mountains on average get stronger and more consistent rainfall than surrounding lower elevations, thus providing needed moisture for hay and grazing pasture production. This country generally stays greener throughout the year because of the elevation that range from 5400^[2]-5800^[2].
