Spanning approximately 160 acres, the property features a diverse array of landscapes, including 21.21 acres of dry crop tucked along the limestone banks of Spring Creek. The property also includes several retention ponds, adding both aesthetic appeal and potential for water management.

In addition to the cropland, the property offers 79.62 acres of lush CRP land, with contracts expiring in 2027 and 2030. This portion of the property serves as prime habitat for upland birds and provides bedding areas for whitetail deer, enhancing the property's appeal for both wildlife enthusiasts and hunters. The remaining acreage is covered in excellent natural habitat, further supporting a thriving local wildlife population.

## **Region & Climate**

Gage, NE County has a warm temperate climate that generally experiences hot summers and cold winters. The average summer temperature is in the low 80s while winter temperatures dip down into the teens. Precipitation is moderate throughout the year, with an average of 32 inches of rain per year. Snowfall during the winter months can range from light to heavy, depending on the year, with an average snowfall of about 21 inches per season. Overall, Gage has a mild climate with distinct seasons that make for enjoyable outdoor activities year-round. On average, there are 216 sunny days per year in Gage County. The US average is 205 sunny days.

Gage County gets some kind of precipitation, on average, 80 days per year.


