The property offers a secluded and quiet setting yet is conveniently located 40 minutes from the Montrose/Telluride Regional Airport in Montrose, CO.

Hunters will appreciate the fact the property is located in state Game Management Unit (GMU) 62, which produces great bucks and bulls each year, while anglers will be drawn to the region's noted Gold Medal trout fishing opportunities. Golfers can take advantage of the fact the property is less than 3 miles from the Divide Ranch & Golf Club in Ridgway, featuring a golf course with more mountain views and a pro shop, and is less than a half hour from Ouray, known as the "Switzerland of America" and for its natural hot springs—just the place to rejuvenate after a day spent in the great outdoors. Topping off the list of attributes, the property is less than an hour from the world-renowned Telluride Ski Resort, offering more than 2,000 skiable acres customized for all ability levels.

Return home and re-immerse yourself in the beauty of nature while sitting under the stars in a place suited for outdoor enthusiasts and families alike.

Region & Climate

Enjoy year-round recreation in a region of Colorado known for its serene beauty and pleasant climate. Spend the day hiking, golfing, hunting or fishing or kayaking in the Ridgway Reservoir, or venture into Ridgway, Ouray or other nearby towns for great dining, shopping and more.

Enjoy a meal at the historic True Grit restaurant in Ridgway, where John Wayne filmed scenes for the movie "True Grit," before venturing into Ouray for a Jeep tour to explore the town's mining history, waterfalls and other off-road adventures. Park goers and anglers will want to visit nearby Montrose, known for the Black Canyon of the Gunnison National Park—the deepest canyon in the world for its narrow width where the Gunnison River offers superb trout fishing—and the Blue Mesa Reservoir, which holds the state's lake trout record.

Ridgway features a semi-arid climate with mild temperatures year-round. Summers are warm and sunny, with occasional rainstorms in the afternoons. Winters are typically cold and dry, with occasional snowfall at the higher elevations. The region is relatively dry overall, with annual precipitation averaging about 12 inches per year. The region enjoys sunny days during the majority of the year, making it an ideal location for outdoor recreation.

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
