



At the heart of the property lies a strategically placed 1-acre alfalfa food plot, which has become a magnet for deer activity. This offering is outfitted with a premium All Seasons Feeders tower blind, multiple ladder tree stand sets, and a 2,000-pound bulk steel gravity feeder, providing a turnkey setup for hunters seeking immediate success. Surrounding this are approximately 106 acres of native grasses, and mature timber that create excellent bedding areas and natural travel corridors for deer and other game species.

A wet weather creek meanders through the property, providing a seasonal water source and enhancing the habitat with its tree-lined banks. The creek corridor is rich with mature timber and intersected by heavily used game trails, rub lines, and scrapes, clear evidence of consistent deer movement.


