Recreation

This unique offering boasts multiple opportunities for hunting, from small game, upland birds, deer, wild turkey, doves and waterfowl. On a single site visit we witnessed a Mule Deer doe with her fawn grazing in one of the many draws which offer plentiful lush forage due to the sub irrigated grasses and plant life from the seep of the Riverside Canal and other sources. These draws are also heavily treed in many areas providing ample cover for all the game that frequents this property. On the same site visit we heard the whistle of Bobwhite Quail, had a visit from a gang of Wild Turkeys and saw hundreds of doves. McFarland Pond Reservoir is certainly a top feature of this property, this approximately 2-acre pond is a water source for all the game living on or near the property, a private fishing hole as well as a waterfowl hunter's dream. The pond stays full year-round from the multiple sources of seep water and stays open most of the winter for the same reason. Being less than a mile from the South Platte River and in close proximity to thousands of acres of feed fields, this pond will attract teal, all species of ducks and geese all within walking distance from the custom-built log home.


