121 Acres:

- Recent timber harvesting has allowed more sunlight to the forest floor spawning the quick regeneration of "young forest" wildlife habitat. Nutritional vegetation sprouts along with healthy shrubs and saplings providing thick cover that deer, turkey and rabbits thrive in
- Timbered ridge tops and draws with lots of oak trees provide essential mast production for deer and turkey
- Elevated build site choices offering amazing views for a cabin or forever home
- Excellent trail network throughout providing access to all parts of the property
- The terrain is level along the 3000 ft of county road frontage, then traverses up a sloped hillside to a series of level ridge tops with amazing views
- This property is currently enrolled in the Tennessee Greenbelt program
 meaning property taxes are significantly reduced. This program can be
 transferred to a new owner so they too can enjoy the same reduced property
 tax benefits that are currently in place
- Power and high speed internet for WIFi available at the road
- Two wet weather creeks
- Unrestricted and no HOA
