Location

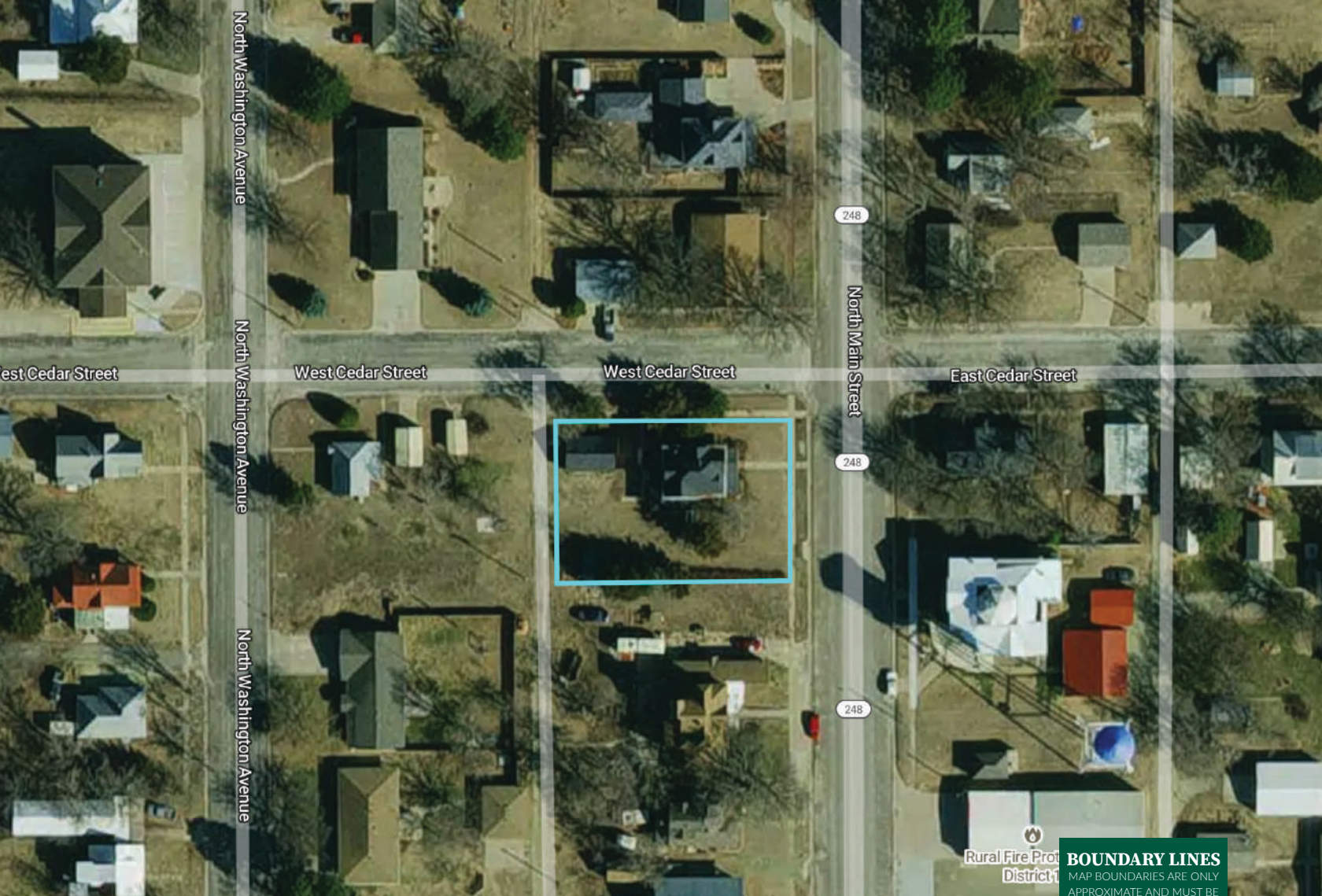

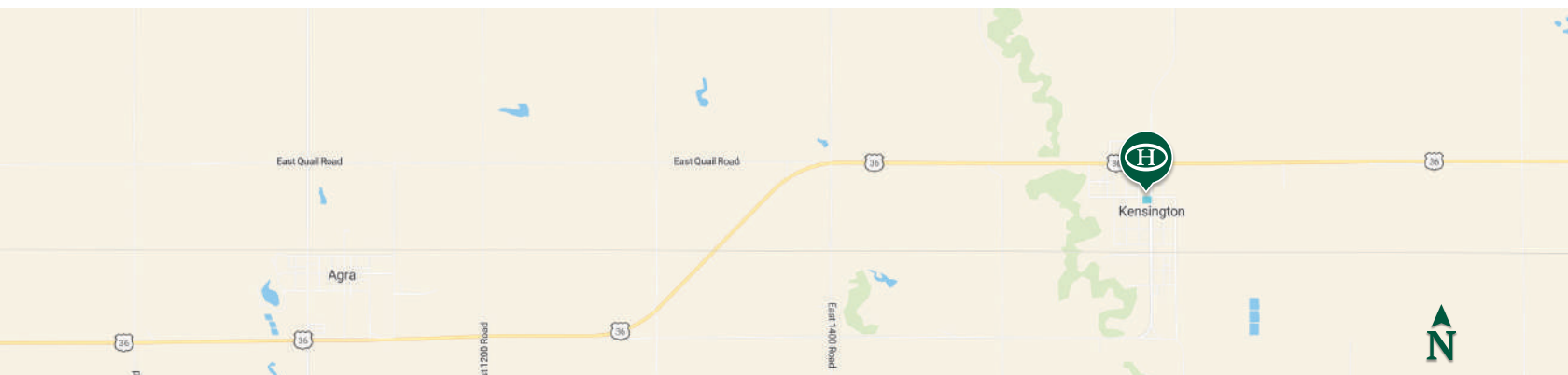
