Land

The ranch is defined by its crystal-clear spring-fed lakes and streams, mature hardwood forests, scenic limestone bluffs, and miles of winding trails that invite exploration on foot, horseback, or UTV. Every corner of the property reflects decades of thoughtful stewardship, creating a setting where natural beauty, recreation, and tranquility.

Throughout its remarkable history, Meadow Lake Ranch has become a destination for families, corporate retreats, weddings, and outdoor enthusiasts while also gaining national recognition as one of Oklahoma's premier filming locations. The ranch served as a principal filming location for the Academy Award-winning film *Minari* and has hosted numerous feature films, television productions, commercials, documentaries, and special productions. Its extraordinary landscape and unique character have also been showcased in countless news stories, travel publications, television features, and statewide tourism campaigns, further establishing Meadow Lake Ranch as one of Oklahoma's most recognized and celebrated destination properties.

Following his memorable stay, the lakeside cabin where he stayed was permanently renamed "Paul's Cabin," preserving a unique chapter in the ranch's rich history and adding to the property's enduring legacy.

Today, Meadow Lake Ranch offers an extraordinary combination of privacy, natural beauty, and established improvements. Trophy fishing in spring-fed lakes, abundant wildlife, miles of scenic trails, luxury lodging, and exceptional event facilities create a destination equally suited as a private family estate, luxury recreational ranch, corporate retreat, premier event venue, or investment opportunity.

Improvements

Lake Side Cabins

Three beautifully crafted 450-square-foot log cabins are positioned along the shores of the ranch's picturesque lakes, each thoughtfully designed to provide a private and relaxing retreat. Identical in design, every cabin features one bedroom, a full bathroom, a fully equipped kitchen with dining area, and comfortable living space that captures the charm of an authentic lakeside lodge. Each cabin opens onto a private concrete patio overlooking the surrounding landscape and is complemented by ample parking and its own custom-built fishing pier, allowing guests to enjoy immediate access to the ranch's crystal-clear spring-fed lakes and exceptional fishing.

Lodge

Serving as the centerpiece of the ranch is the impressive 1,600-square-foot Main Lodge and Office, perfectly situated between two of the property's scenic lakes. The lodge welcomes guests with vaulted ceilings, beautiful interior log siding, and expansive French doors and oversized windows that showcase views of the professionally landscaped grounds, waterfalls, and surrounding lakes. Designed for both hospitality and business operations, the lodge includes a fully equipped commercial-style kitchen, generous pantry and storage areas, two half bathrooms, and four full bathrooms, making it well suited for hosting guests, coordinating events, and supporting day-to-day ranch operations.

Event Center

The custom-built 2,400-square-foot Event Center was designed to accommodate weddings, corporate retreats, conferences, reunions, and private celebrations in an unforgettable natural setting. Constructed with sound-insulated walls, ADA-compliant commercial entrances, large windows, and an expansive open floor plan, the venue offers exceptional flexibility while embracing the beauty of its surroundings. Connected to the Main Lodge by beautifully designed sidewalks and custom walkways, the Event Center is nestled within a heavily wooded park-like setting enhanced by professionally designed landscaping, cascading waterfalls, and water features. Spacious gathering patios, decorative concrete and native stone retaining walls, custom gazebos, and a large fire pit create inviting outdoor spaces where guests can relax and enjoy the peaceful atmosphere.





Maintenance Building and Additional Cabins

Supporting the ranch's daily operations is a substantial 4,020-square-foot steel maintenance and equipment building, thoughtfully designed for efficiency and long-term durability. Constructed with high ceilings, multiple overhead roll-up doors, concrete flooring, full electrical service, water, and frost-free hydrants, the building provides ample space for equipment storage, maintenance operations, tools, supplies, and ranch support vehicles. The facility has served as the operational backbone of Meadow Lake Ranch, ensuring the property has been maintained throughout its history.

Attached to the eastern side of the building are two additional walkout guest cabins, each offering approximately 684 square feet each of comfortable living space. Both cabins feature one bedroom, a full bathroom, a spacious living area, a full kitchen, and private patios overlooking the ranch. One cabin is currently utilized as a laundry facility and additional storage for the ranch's hospitality operation but was originally designed as guest accommodations and can easily be returned to a fully functional cabin.

Perched on one of the property's higher elevations, these cabins enjoy sweeping panoramic views across Meadow Lake Ranch's spring-fed lakes, mature hardwood forests, and beautifully landscaped grounds. On clear days, guests are treated to remarkable views extending toward the Tulsa skyline, offering a unique combination of peaceful seclusion and proximity to one of Oklahoma's largest metropolitan areas.

Gun Range

Located within a secluded area of the property is a professionally constructed shooting range designed with both safety and functionality in mind. The range features multiple shooting distances suitable for a variety of firearms, including centerfire rifles, rimfire rifles, and traditional black powder rifles. Engineered earthen berms, strategically positioned steel targets, and carefully planned shooting lanes provide a safe and enjoyable shooting environment for recreational target practice and marksmanship training.

A custom-built steel shooting house with a concrete floor offers a comfortable and weather-protected shooting platform, allowing year-round use while enhancing both safety and convenience. The secluded setting provides excellent privacy, ensuring the range remains an outstanding recreational amenity without impacting other areas of the ranch.





Horse Barn & Livestock Facility

Designed with both functionality and craftsmanship in mind, Meadow Lake Ranch features an exceptional equestrian and livestock complex that reflects the property's heritage as an authentic dude ranch. Every improvement has been custom built using quality materials and heavy-duty construction, creating facilities that are both attractive and built for years of dependable use.

The custom-designed 11' x 70' horse barn features steel construction with attractive wood exterior finishes that blend seamlessly with the ranch's rustic setting. The barn offers five individual horse stalls, a dedicated tack and storage room, and direct access to adjoining holding pens and small turnout pastures, creating an efficient layout for horse care and daily operations.

Adjacent to the barn is a well-planned livestock working facility complete with sorting pens, working chutes, and a hydraulic head catch, allowing for efficient livestock handling, vaccinations, and routine herd management. A 50-foot round pen provides an ideal environment for horse training and groundwork, while the 20,000-square-foot riding arena offers ample space for riding, training, clinics, and recreational equestrian activities.

Supporting the operation is a custom-built 30' x 40' steel hay barn with the capacity to store approximately 110 round bales, providing excellent protection for hay and feed throughout the year.

The entire livestock complex is enclosed with custom fencing constructed of heavy-duty steel pipe, welded cattle panels, and quality barbed wire. Every gate, corner brace, and working component was built with durability, safety, and long-term performance in mind, reflecting the exceptional level of craftsmanship found throughout Meadow Lake Ranch. The ranch can support a small herd of around 30 cow calf pairs.

Activities

Meadow Lake Ranch was thoughtfully designed to bring people together, offering a variety of outdoor recreational amenities that have hosted countless family gatherings, corporate retreats, weddings, and special events over the years.

A dedicated recreation area features an established tomahawk throwing course, archery range, horseshoe courts, and a calf roping course, all of which remain in place and are ready to be enjoyed by future owners and guests. These amenities provide a unique western experience while honoring the ranch's heritage as an authentic dude ranch.

Surrounding the activity areas are numerous custom concrete patios and gathering spaces, thoughtfully positioned throughout the beautifully landscaped grounds. Comfortable outdoor seating, fire pits, and scenic overlooks create inviting places for family and friends to relax, visit, and enjoy the peaceful surroundings after a day of outdoor adventure. Whether sharing stories around the fire, enjoying an evening overlooking the lakes, or hosting group activities, these gathering areas encourage memorable experiences for guests of every generation.

Landscaping and water features

The grounds surrounding the Event Center have been meticulously designed to create one of the ranch's most impressive gathering areas. A custom underground irrigation system supports professionally landscaped lawns, gardens, and mature plantings while supplying an extensive collection of ornamental water features, cascading waterfalls, and ponds throughout the venue. Custom sidewalks, decorative concrete patios, native stone retaining walls, gazebos, and inviting fire pit areas blend seamlessly into the surrounding hardwood forest, creating a peaceful, park-like setting that is both visually stunning and exceptionally functional for entertaining guests year-round.

Other

Supporting the property's day-to-day operation is a dedicated firewood processing and storage area, designed to efficiently supply the numerous cabins, fire pits, and gathering areas located throughout the ranch. Throughout the year, hardwood timber harvested from routine property maintenance is accumulated and processed into firewood using an organized cutting, splitting, and storage system. This dedicated area provides an efficient workflow while maintaining a readily available supply of seasoned firewood for guests and ranch operations. Further enhancing the ranch's versatility is a separate, privately situated poultry enclosure designed for raising chickens and other domestic fowl. Located away from the main improvements, the facility provides a secure and spacious environment that has supported the ranch's hospitality operations while offering opportunities for fresh eggs, hobby farming, or small-scale agricultural pursuits.

All cabins, lodging facilities, and primary improvements are serviced by underground electrical utilities, eliminating the visual impact of overhead power lines and enhancing the ranch's clean, park-like appearance.

The property is served by a dependable public rural water system, providing reliable water service to the cabins, lodge, event center, and supporting improvements. An extensive network of well-maintained graveled interior roads provides convenient year-round access throughout the ranch, allowing guests and service vehicles to comfortably reach every major improvement and recreational amenity. Adding to its accessibility, the ranch enjoys frontage and access from three paved county roads, providing exceptional convenience, multiple points of entry, and excellent circulation throughout the property.





Recreation

Established trails meander through towering hardwood timber, across native meadows, and alongside picturesque streams, making the ranch ideal for hiking, horseback riding, mountain biking, ATV and UTV adventures, and wildlife photography. Scenic overlooks, waterfalls, and secluded lakefront settings offer breathtaking views throughout the property, with every trail revealing another unforgettable landscape.

The ranch supports an abundance of wildlife and has long been recognized for its outstanding outdoor recreation. Healthy populations of whitetail deer, wild turkey, waterfowl, and native small game thrive within the diverse habitat, providing exceptional wildlife viewing and outstanding hunting opportunities. An established waterfowl hunting blind overlooks one of the ranch's productive lakes, offering excellent duck hunting during migration, while the surrounding timber and rolling terrain create ideal habitat for quality deer and turkey hunting.

The cemetery is preserved in its natural setting and is recognized as a historic feature of the ranch. 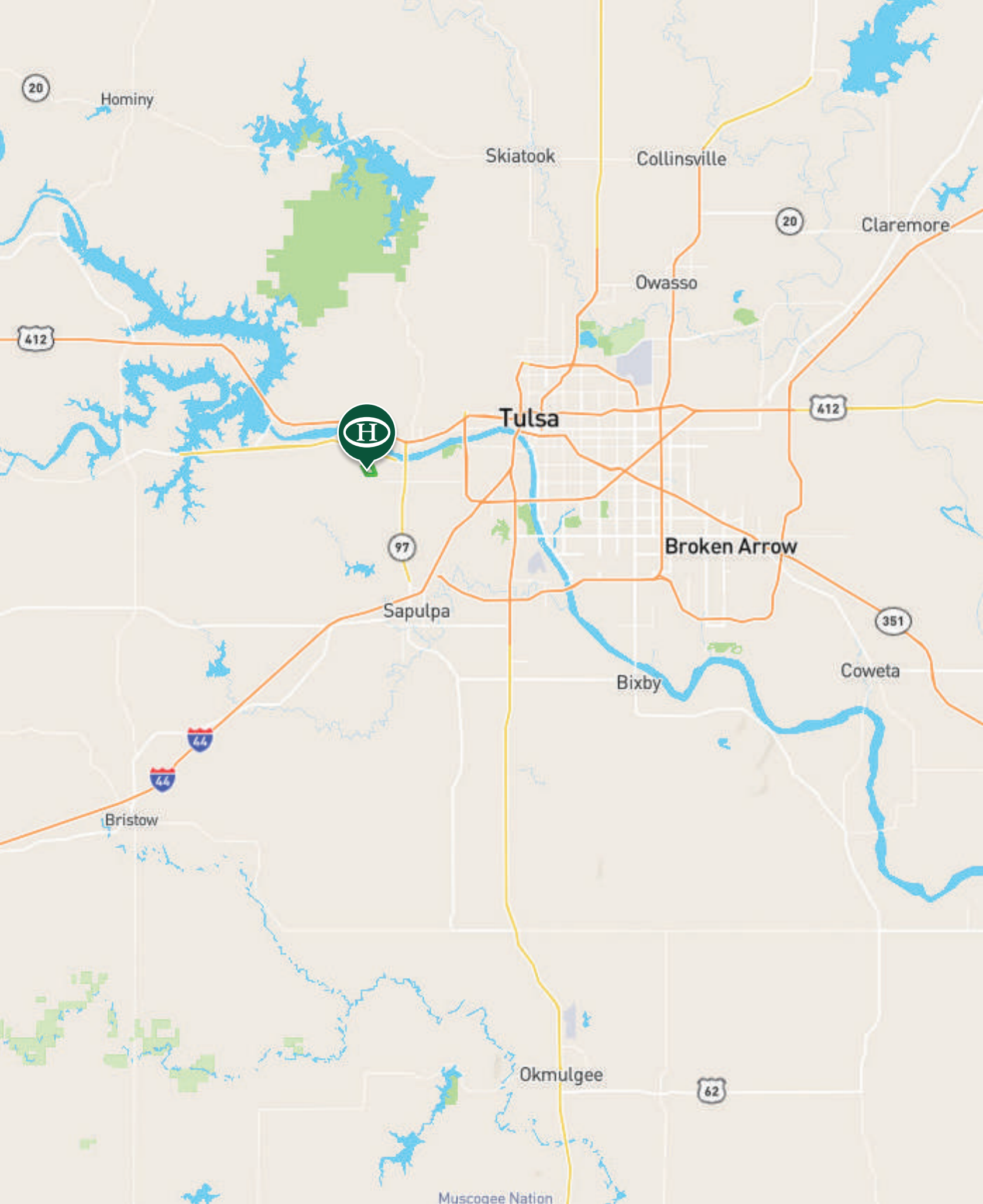
